We are seeking an enthusiastic and committed Football and Education Coach to lead the delivery of football training sessions and fixtures within our Post 16 Football and Education Programme. The successful candidate will play a key role in developing players, creating a positive learning environment, and helping participants maximise their footballing potential.

The Football and Education Programme was launched in 2009, making Redditch United one of the longest established programmes of its kind in the country.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Plan, deliver and evaluate high quality football coaching sessions in line with the Redditch United DNA.
- Lead Football and Education training sessions on Mondays and Tuesdays.
- Lead the team on matchdays, including squad selection, pre match preparation, match management and post-match reviews.
- Support the technical, tactical, physical and personal development of players within the programme.
- Monitor player progress and provide appropriate feedback to support development.
- Maintain a safe, positive and inclusive learning environment for all participants.
- Ensure safeguarding and player welfare standards are always upheld.
- Liaise with club staff regarding training schedules, fixtures and player availability.
- Promote high standards of behaviour, attendance, commitment and professionalism amongst players.
- Support talented players in progressing towards senior football opportunities where appropriate.
- Represent Redditch United professionally at all training sessions, fixtures and programme events.
- Complete any relevant coaching administration associated with training sessions and fixtures.

Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)

- Deliver engaging and high-quality coaching sessions throughout the season.
- Maintain excellent attendance and engagement levels amongst players.
- Ensure players demonstrate measurable technical and tactical development.
- Create positive pathways for players into senior football and other progression opportunities.

- Contribute to a positive experience for all players enrolled on the programme.



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Hours of Work

- Training sessions are currently scheduled from **1:30pm to 3:30pm on Mondays and Tuesdays.**
- Matchdays are generally played on **Wednesday afternoons**, with fixtures taking place at **The Valley Stadium** and other venues across the Midlands.
- Additional time may be required for fixture travel, matchday preparation and session planning.
- Additional hours may occasionally be required to meet the needs of the programme and fixtures schedule.

- A minimum FA UEFA C (Level 2) Football qualification (or equivalent) is desirable.
- Previous experience coaching players aged 16 to 19 is desirable.
- Excellent communication and organisational skills.
- Ability to work effectively within a team environment.

- Holding a D1 Minibus Licence is advantageous but not essential.
